What is your Goliath?

In my quiet time this month, I read I Samuel Chapter 17. This is the story of David and Goliath. David, a young Shepherd man who had the heart of God, spent his time with his sheep singing many of the Psalms, talking to God, and protecting his sheep from the lions and the bears. He trusted God with all his heart.



Most of the onlookers saw only a defiant giant. David, however, saw a mortal man defying Almighty God. David in his heart knew he would not be facing Goliath alone. David said to the Philistine, "you come against me with sword and spear and javelin, but I come against you in the name of the Lord Almighty, the God of the armies of Israel, whom you

have defied." So David picked up five stone and his sling shot and killed the giant.

What is our Goliath? Overspending, anger, gossip, jealousy, loneliness, lust, lying, lack of faith, addictions, etc. In Proverbs 6: 16-19, God tells us there are six things the Lord hates, seven that are detestable to Him: haughty eyes, a lying tongue, hands that shed innocent blood, a heart that devises wicked schemes, feet that are quick to rush into evil, a false witness who pours out lies, and a man who stirs up dissension among brothers.

So let us pick up our sling shot and five stones [prayer] and slay the giant. Our Good Shepherd is Jesus Christ and He protects His sheep.

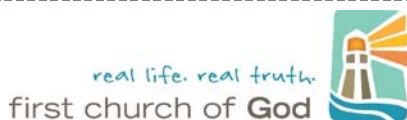
